#### **Adelaide Place Baptist Church commits to:**

- everyone feels able to speak out about are present safeguarding concerns
- The creation of a safe environment and Carry out risk assessments and put culture where all are welcome and safeguarding measures in place where risks
- Pastoral care for victims and survivors of Pastoral care for those who are the abuse, and other people who have been subject of concerns or allegations affected by safeguarding issues
- A prompt and appropriate response to Safe recruitment of all those who have every safeguarding concern or allegation responsibility for children and adults who regardless of status or circumstance
  - may be vulnerable
- The promotion of good safeguarding Responding to concerns with practice through effective training, professionalism and respect for people's guidance, policy and procedures
  - privacy, where information is only shared with necessary parties


